

Qualification Criteria (Draft, subject to possible updates in the Request For Proposals Documents)

(Without Initial Selection)

Wherever a Proposer is required to state a monetary amount, Proposers should indicate the USD equivalent using the rate of exchange determined as follows:

- For construction turnover or financial data required for each year - Exchange rate prevailing on the last day of the respective calendar year (in which the amounts for that year are to be converted) was originally established.
- The monetary value of the past contract references will be calculated with the following approach:

For contracts denominated in United States Dollars (USD):

The contract price at contract signing date shall be updated to present value using the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) Producer Price Index (PPI): Final Demand (Series ID: WPUFD4), based on the index value applicable 14 days prior to the bid submission deadline.

For contracts denominated in other currencies:

- The contract price shall first be converted into United States Dollars (USD) using the exchange rate applicable on the contract signing date.
- The amount converted into USD shall then be updated to present value using the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) Producer Price Index (PPI): Final Demand (Series ID: WPUFD4), based on the index value applicable 14 days prior to the bid submission deadline.

The official source of the (exchange) rate is selling rate published on the website of the Central Bank Republic of Türkiye (<http://www.tcmb.gov.tr>). Any error in determining the exchange rates in the Proposal may be corrected by the Employer.

1. Qualification

1.1 Updated Information

The Proposer's qualification shall be assessed in accordance with the Qualification table included in this section.

1.2 Subcontractors

Only the Specialized Subcontractors as approved by the Employer will be considered. The Proposer shall provide in Section IV, Proposal Forms the relevant details of all proposed subcontractors.

1.3 Financial Resources

Using the relevant Form No FIN 3.1 in Section IV, Proposal Forms, the Proposer must demonstrate access to, or availability of, financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments to meet the overall cash flow requirements for this Contract and its current Works commitment.

1.4 Contractor's Representative and Key Personnel

The Proposer must demonstrate that it will have a suitably qualified Contractor's Representative and suitably qualified (and in adequate numbers) minimum Key Personnel, as listed below and described in the Employer's Requirements.

Note: If the Proposer submits proposals for multiple lots, it must propose separate teams of key personnel for each lot. Specifically, for each of the below listed key personnel positions different persons should be proposed for the multiple lots, such that the same person is not common in the multiple lots.

If any of the Key Personnel proposed by the Proposer is determined by the Employer not meeting the specified requirements, the Employer reserves the right to require the Proposer to replace such key personnel with the fully qualified and experienced key personnel prior to contract award, if awarded to the Proposer.

1.5 Equipment

The Proposer must demonstrate that it has access to the key equipment listed hereafter:

Note: If the Proposer submits proposals for multiple lots, it must propose separate equipment for each lot. Specifically, for each of the below listed equipment different equipment should be proposed for the multiple lots, such that the same equipment is not common in the multiple lots.

If any of the key equipment proposed by the Proposer is determined by the Employer not meeting the specified characteristics, the Employer reserves the right to require the Proposer to replace such key equipment with the key equipment that meets the specified characteristics prior to contract award, if awarded to the Proposer.

The Proposer shall provide its strategy for acquiring and maintaining the key equipment that may be needed to execute the Works in accordance with the Work Program.

The Proposer shall provide details in the relevant Form in Section IV.

2. Multiple Contracts (ITP 40.3)

In accordance with **ITP 1.1**, Proposals are invited for one or more lots, the contract will be awarded to the Proposer or Proposers with the Most Advantageous Proposal for the individual lots.

However, if a Proposer, with Proposals that are substantially responsive and with highest evaluated score for individual lots, is not qualified for the combination of the lots, then the award will be made based on the highest total score for combination of lots for which Proposers are qualified.

Cross discounts for award of multiple lots will not be considered.

Qualification Criteria for Multiple Contracts

The criteria for qualification are the aggregate (cumulative sum of) minimum requirement for respective lots as specified under items 3.1 (financial capability), 3.2 (average annual construction turnover), 4.2(a) (Specific Construction & Contract Management Experience) and 4.2(b) (Key Activities) of Section III. With respect to the specific experience under item 4.2(a), minimum requirements for combined contract(s) shall be the aggregate requirements for each lot for which the Proposer has bid, and the Proposer's referenced contracts for each lot shall be different.
